## The following items can be accepted at our facility from residents and area businesses:

- Co-Mix Materials (includes brown, clear or green glass bottles; metal cans and aluminum foil products i.e. aluminum and steel/tin metal food and beverage cans and pie pans; #1 and #2 Plastic Bottles including milk jugs, soda bottles, household cleaner bottles, laundry detergent bottles, shampoo bottles, and other similar bottles and jugs. *Note: Items should be rinsed and lids removed, plastic bottles must also have a narrow "neck" or pour spout.*)
- Mixed Paper Materials (including paper grocery bags, magazines, telephone books, junk Mail, Catalogs, Cards, Stationery, School Paper, Computer Paper, Shredded Paper (in paper bags), Single-layer Cardboard (cereal boxes, tissue boxes, paper towel rolls etc.)
- > Corrugated Cardboard
- > Hard-Bound Books
- > **Paper Board** (i.e. cereal boxes, drink boxes)
- > Used Cooking Oil (up to 5 gallons/person/day)
- > Used Motor Oil (up to 5 gallons/person/day)
- > Antifreeze (up to 5 gallons/person/day)
- > Tires (\$1.50/tire rim removed; \$3.00/tire with rim; additional fees apply for oversized tires)
- > Large (vehicle-type) batteries

## **GUIDELINES**

- Collection Containers are clearly labeled. All items must be placed in the proper container. Placing other materials in the containers may render the entire load unmarketable. Additional white, color, and computer paper collection boxes are located inside the bay area of the Waste Management Center building. PLEASE DO NOT PUT ANYTHING OTHER THAN WHITE, COLORED, OR MIXED OFFICE PAPER INTO THE APPROPRIATELY LABELLED BOX.
- Cardboard can be placed in the large wire container designated for cardboard. Please make sure that the cardboard does not contain any wood, Styrofoam, straps, paper, or trash – otherwise it cannot be recycled. Packing paper only may be placed in one or more of the boxes or in the paper container located outside. We also cannot recycle cardboard that is coated in wax, oil, food, or any other contaminant.
- Large quantities of cardboard can be delivered throughout the week; however, we request that such deliveries be made before noon on Fridays and Saturdays.
