From Interstate I-64. Exit Battlefield Blvd. South. Travel south on Battlefield Blvd. towards Chesapeake General Hospital (approx. 2 miles). Turn left at stop light just past the Woodford Square Shopping Center at Gainsborough Square Drive (between McDonald's and Shopping Center/Rose's). Travel to the end of Gainsborough Square Drive to intersection with Oak Grove Road. The Chesapeake Arboretum Headquarters is to the left at the corner of Gainsborough Square Drive and Oak Grove Road. Turn left on Oak Grove Road and left again into the large gravel parking lot.

#### Things You Should Know . . .

**Tree Planting Teams.** Groups, organizations, and individuals are invited to join tree planting teams.

**Supplies and Equipment Needed.** If your tree planting team can furnish the following supplies, it will be helpful:

- \* One-Gallon Milk Jugs Filled With Water. Two per volunteer. To help water the newly planted trees.
- \* Work Gloves. One pair per volunteer.
- \* Shovels. One per volunteer.
- \* Hand Cart or Wheelbarrow (Optional).
- \* **Truck.** Please bring if your team has a truck.

**Protective Clothing.** Since all work will take place outdoors, please plan to dress for the weather. The following tips will be helpful for you.

- \* Layers. Dressing in layers will help you cope with temperature changes.
- \* Long Sleeves and Pants. Long sleeves and pants will help guard against excess sun, insects, and poison ivy.
- \* **Shoes.** Closed-toe shoes and socks are preferable to sandals for this type of work.
- \* Sun block lotion or insect repellant. Depending upon the weather, you may want to take precautions to avoid over-exposure to the sun or insects.

*Keep Chesapeake Beautiful* Lapel Pins. A beautiful lapel pin will be presented to each tree planting volunteer.

*Keep Chesapeake Beautiful* Flag. Each registered group of 20 or more volunteers will receive a flag.
