PAPER & PAPER PRODUCTS

- no pizza boxes
- * empty and clean, please



paper
newspaper
mail supplements
phone books
magazines
flattened cardboard boxes
cardboard rolls

PLASTIC BOTTLES

- no polystyrene (Styrofoam)
- * empty, please



water bottles
soda bottles
milk jugs
household products
cleaning product bottles

usually marked 1 or 2

GLASS

- * empty, please



glass jars
glass bottles

any colors accepted

ALUMINUM & TIN

- * clean, please



steel & tin cans
aluminum cans & foil
aluminum pie plates
& containers
